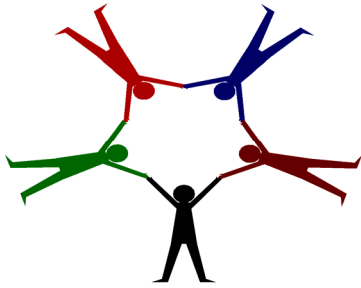

Whatever happened to the real Rain Man, the quiet genius, Kim Peek, whose extraordinary life story inspired the character played by Dustin Hoffman? Since the Oscar-winning movie *Rain Man* became a worldwide hit, the once-reclusive Kim Peek has wowed and thrilled over a half million people, demonstrating his phenomenal brain power.

In the course of his preparation for playing the part of Raymond Babbitt in *Rain Man*, Dustin Hoffman met with Kim Peek and his father in February, 1987. Fran Peek describes that "special day with Dustin" at length in his book about Kim and chronicles in some detail Kim's encyclopedic memory feats as shared with Mr. Hoffman including facts about British monarchs, the Bible, baseball, horse racing, dates, times, places, composers, melodies, movies, geography, space program, authors and literature. Dustin Hoffman's parting remark to Kim, according to his father was: "I may be the star, but you are the heavens."
